1973 - 1974**

**1973**

In the spring of 1973, the Presbyters of Southern Missouri District A/G appointed Rev. Paul Feller (Glass Eye) to be the RR District Commander, making him the Chairman of the RR and FCF committees. This position was previously held by Rev. James Griggs (Golden Eagle), who still retained his position as Executive Director of the Men's Department. Rev. Feller reported to him.

Twenty-one new members were initiated into the Daniel Boone Chapter at the June 9 and June 16 Pow Wow's.

The Daniel Boone Chapter Fall Outing was held on September 7 and 8, 1973 in Missouri Town, which is at Lake Jacomo County Park, about fifteen minutes southeast of Kansas City. Over 60 men and boys attended the outing and enjoyed a wild game dinner on Friday night and a Frontiersman breakfast on Saturday morning. On Saturday, everyone had an opportunity to visit Old Frontier Town and to participate in all the contests.

On November 2 and 3, 1973, the Plainsman Territorial Rendezvous was held at Piney Creek, Missouri. Many of the Daniel Boone members attended. Everyone enjoyed a great time of fellowship.

**1974**

In the spring of 1974, Don Ray (Dead Fox) resigned his position as Daniel Boone Chapter president to become the Territorial Representative for the Plainsman Territory.

The first National Camporama was held August 20-24, 1974 at the Air Force Academy in Colorado. The FCF encampment was one of the highlights of the Camporama. The frontiersmen dressed in their skins and lived in Teepees, Bakers Tents, etc. They demonstrated how to throw a hawk and knife, cook frontier style and start a fire with flint and steel. The members of the Daniel Boone Chapter participated in all phases of the Camporama, including the frontier village.

The Daniel Boone Chapter Fall Outing was held on September 13-14, 1974, on the Sutherland farm near Fairgrove, Missouri, in the Southwest Division. In the Friday evening business meeting, Jerry Haines was elected president and Danny Bixler was elected District Scout. Five Greenhorns were initiated at this outing. A total of 25 was initiated into the Daniel Boone Chapter this year.

At the National Royal Ranger Office, Fred Deaver was installed as the National FCF President, Don Bixler as National Scribe, Dean Garrison as National Scout and Dave Massey as National Assistant Scout.
