Working with planters and their teams to see new churches launch across our network is one of the most rewarding things I've ever been a part of. I hope to see a multiplication movement that will propel us to 400 places of worship and beyond!

On May 10th, 2024, we will be hosting a "CMN One Day Experience" that will focus on giving pastors practical methods and resources that will equip them to be multipliers. The event is free, and I would love to see you there! Thank you so much for believing in and supporting Reach Network and the Church Planting Initiative of the Southern Missouri Ministry Network. I'm grateful to partner with such Kingdom-minded people!

CHURCH HEALTH & REVITALIZATION

Church Health and Revitalization continues to offer multiple options for pastors and church leaders to pursue health and vitality to their church.

The Acts 2 Journey: 10 churches completed the Acts 2 Journey in 2023 and are well on their way to implementing their strategies to achieve their newly established vision. Pastors and church leaders worked to develop their Vision, Values, and Strategies to become the church God desires them to become. Each cohort takes place on four retreat weekends which features training on Fridays for Pastors and Spouses, and training for church leadership/vision teams on Saturday.

Many of our Southern Missouri churches continue to struggle to overcome declining attendance. The need for health and revitalization in the local church has never been more critical than it is today with nearly 81% of Assemblies of God churches experiencing plateau or decline in recent years. Pastors and church leaders are challenged to embrace an outward focus upon those far from God in their communities and imitate the church found in Acts 2:42-47. The church in Acts 2 modeled the FIVE Biblical Functions of a healthy church: Connect, Grow, Serve, Go, & Worship. Let's ACT like them and reach our world.

MEN'S MINISTRIES

2023 was another great year for Southern Missouri Men's Ministries. We continue to improve existing ministry through Light for the Lost and our Men's Summits, but we have also been very intentional in helping men grow deeper in their faith and pursue God with all their hearts.

Men's Summit 2023:

In April of last year, we met for our second Men's Summit at Eagle Sky with over 240 men joining us. Brooks Till challenged our men to accept the challenge and follow Christ with everything they have.

Men's Summit at Cross Pointe Camp was also a great weekend of ministry, workshops, and activities. In 2023, we had nearly 600 men join us as Brooks Till encouraged and challenged to pursue God with greater passion.

Disciple Maker Training continues to be a priority for SOMO Men. In 2023, we offered four training events around the Network and had over 100 men in attendance to be trained in how to make disciples. In February of 2024 we hosted another four training events and saw nearly 150 men, women, and teens learn the basics of discipling others.

The Great Commission mandates us to GO and MAKE DISCIPLES. The testimonies of the impact this training has already had have been amazing and we look forward to sharing those stories and many more with you in coming months.

360Man Missionary & Network: Our 360Man Network continues to grow under the leadership of our U.S. Missionary Jason Jacques. Men in local churches around our ministry network are being trained to establish a strong ministry to men in their church AND to raise up other Godly men to serve their church AND their pastor by advancing the Kingdom of God. These men are learning what it means to be a leader in the local church and the church is becoming stronger and healthier as a result.

360Go – Men on Mission: We are taking our first 360Go Missions Trip in October of this year to the nation of Albania. While in Albania, we will be encouraging and training men in the local church as well as conducting an evangelism outreach in one of the major cities with members of our SOMO LFTL Steak Teams. We have accepted the challenge to raise \$20,000 to help the church in Fushe Kruje, Albania purchase a van for ministry. Contact the Men's office to see how you can help us.

2024 is the 40th year of Men's Ministries in Southern Missouri and we believe it will be one of our BEST as we seek to Engage, Equip, and Mobilize today's man in today's local church!

ROYAL RANGERS

The mission of Royal Rangers continued in 2023 as we conducted a variety of events to support the ongoing work of our churches in evangelizing boys for Christ, equipping them to become the next generation of Christlike men, and empowering them for service as life-long servant leaders. Through the leading of the Holy Spirit and the partnership with our churches and ministries we continue our efforts to reach every boy of southern Missouri with the message of the gospel.

MEMBERSHIP

As of the end of the chartering year on August 14, 2023 our Network had 30 chartered outposts, representing 475 leaders and boys.

EVENTS

Our Network returned to our regular schedule of events in 2022 conducted in their usual form. Attendance at most events was lower than last year, including National Camporama in July as churches and outposts seem to continue feeling the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Leaders Conference: The annual Royal Ranger Leaders Conference took place at Oak Grove AG in Springfield in April with 59 people in attendance. The conference began on Friday night with a time of fun & fellowship followed by a missions auction that raised \$2,007 for BGMC Master's Toolbox. Training classes were conducted on Friday. Program updates, event information, and a variety of workshops were provided on Saturday.
- Pow-Wow: Our annual Network Pow-Wow took place in June at Camp Millhouser with 360 leaders and boys in attendance. Our theme was "Star Force Academy" with Jason Jaques, our own SoMo 360 Man missionary serving as our guest speaker. Many responded to the invitations given for salvation or recommitments during the evening services, and each boy responding received a small New Testament.
- Cardboard Boat Regatta: The annual Cardboard Boat Regatta on Stockton Lake was a great success with 120 in attendance, our highest attendance in several years.
- FCF Events: The FCF winter outings were conducted by each division with total attendance of 113 leaders and boys. Frontier Adventure & Spring Trace saw 53 in attendance, with another 42 in attendance at Fall Trace.
- Christmas Party & Retreat: The annual Christmas Party & Retreat at Branson First AG saw 61 in attendance, the largest crowd in several years.
- Territorial Rendezvous: A joint FCF rendezvous was held at Camp Dubois near St. Louis where FCF members from both the Rivermen and Voyagers territories participated. Our Daniel Boone FCF chapter brought the largest group with 47 members in attendance. The weather was nearly perfect, and a great time was had by all.

MISSIONS

In August a group of 14 leaders and boys participated in a Pathfinder Missions trip to the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in Wanblee, SD to assist missionary Gus & Sherry Craven in their ministry to the native Americans in their community. We completed work projects on the ranch and served at a community outreach event in Red Shirt, SD. We then visited Mount Rushmore and toured the bad lands on our way home. Through this event and other missions giving, our men and boys gave \$10,361 to missions in 2023.

ADULT LEADER TRAINING

In 2023 we had 21 individuals complete adult leader training modules including Ranger Foundations, Ranger Essentials, and Ranger Safety. This represents a significant increase over recent years due to the recent change in allowing Districts/Networks to teach these courses in their entirety in a classroom setting.

JUNIOR LEADER TRAINING

A Junior Training Camp (JTC) was conducted in July along with a Junior Academy (JA). A total of 12 boys participated in these camps. A Backpacking Action & Adventure Camp (BAC) was conducted along the Buffalo River in June with 21 boys & leaders attending, and a Missions Action Camp (MAC) was conducted in conjunction with the Pathfinder Missions trip in July with 14 participants.

AWARDS

Three boys earned the Gold Medal of Achievement (GMA) in 2023: Joshua Arendt, Parker Hoel, and Joseph Whitaker. The Network Outstanding Service Award was presented to 24 adult leaders in recognition of 20 or more years of service as an adult Royal Rangers leader in our Network.

STAFF UPDATE

Don Bixler stepped down from his role as Northwest Division Commander after having served in that role for nearly 60 years.
