UNSHAKEN FAITH

Unshaken faith only comes from tested faith. Dr. "C" Charles Harris a professor of mine at Central Bible College would hand out a test with a smile and say, "You can't have a testimony without a test."

We serve a loving God that knows that our "walk of faith" cannot be successful without His testing of our faith! Job understood that testing would produce a pure faith in his life! Job 23:10 But He knows the way that I take; When He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold.

GOD FEELS THAT OUR FAITH SHOULD BE TESTED!

Gen 22:1 Now it came to pass after these things that God tested Abraham

- If you're having heart trouble your physician will ask you to take a stress test. The reason for the test is not to give you a heart attack, but to find out how well your heart is functioning!

- God doesn't test us to destroy us but to let us see how well our faith is functioning. If there are areas of weakness we need to see it and correct it.

Satan tempts us to destroy our faith. God tests us to increase our faith.

God tests us to see if we will give the things we love the most to him in worship. Gen 22:2 Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you."

ABRAHAM GIVES US THE PROPER RESPONSE WHEN OUR FAITH IS TESTED.

Abraham responded quickly to God's command! 3" So Abraham rose early in the morning and saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son"

- Don't drag your feet, the sooner you take the test the sooner you'll reap the benefits!

Abraham responded thoughtfully and thoroughly to God's command. 6 "So Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife, and the two of them went together."

- He didn't go crazy and lose reasoning, though he responded quickly, he took time and prepared himself for the test.

- If you're being tested by God, respond quickly, but do it thought-fully and thoroughly.

Abraham responded obediently.

- Abraham traveled for three days to the land of Moriah! 4 "Then on the third day Abraham lifted his eyes and saw the place afar off."

Abraham responded silently.

- Abraham never shared this with anyone. God had spoken directly and he knew what he had to do.

- When faced with the unpleasant task of doing the right thing <u>do not</u> to seek out sympathizers.

- If you need clarification seek wise guidance, but don't seek out sympathizers.

ABRAHAM SHOWS US WHAT UNSHAKEN FAITH CAN DO.

Unshaken faith will cause you to go a little farther. 5 "And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship"

- Faith in God will enable you to go farther than you ever thought possible!

- If Abraham had been asked if he could have done what God had asked Him prior to the test, he would have said no.

Unshaken faith will cause you to worship during the times of testing. 5 "And Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; the lad and I will go yonder and worship"

Unshaken faith during your test will bring calmness.

- Abraham's faith produced calmness in his life that touched others. The two young men and Isaac stood steady during this time of incredible testing!

- Your unshaken faith shown during the times of testing should bring calmness to those around!

ABRAHAM'S UNSHAKEN FAITH PASSED GOD'S TEST.

We pass the test when God speaks clearly and forcefully into our lives.

Gen. 23:11 "But the Angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" So he said, "Here I am." 12 And He said, "Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me."

- There is a place during the test of your faith when God speaks into your life and you know it!

When our faith in God is tested but unshaken there will always be provision for our present day and promise for the future ahead.

- Gen. 23:13-14 Abraham's unshaken faith meet "Jehovah-Jireh" The-Lord –Will- Provide. The same will be true for each of us in our times of testing.

- Gen. 23: 15-18 Abraham's unshaken faith heard the promise of an everlasting covenant. 17 "blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. 18 In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

Unshakable – If someone's trust or belief is unshakable, it is firm and cannot be made weaker or destroyed.



THE UN-SHAKABLE CHURCH

As I read about the first century church described in the book of Acts, I cannot help but think how different the church was than anything of its time. In fact, the entire ministry of Jesus was different than anything anyone had experienced. I believe that was the point. If there was ever a time we needed a church that was different than everything around it – it's now – it's here.

The Apostle Paul warned Timothy (2 *Tim 3:1-5*) of a time in the last days when everything would be distorted and evil. He also referred to the world as warped and crooked (*Phil 2:15*). I think that pretty well describes the world in which we live, right? It seems like every system and institution that were once thought reliable and stable have been shaken. Everything around us is in disarray, EXCEPT for the Church!

In any building project, you MUST have a solid foundation to give strength to whatever structure you're going to build. If the foundation crumbles, it's only a matter of time before the rest of the structure crumbles and falls. But if the foundation remains solid and secure—the structure you build will also be secure. You probably already see the connection.

According to 1 Peter 2:6 (NIV), our cornerstone is not a "**what**" but a "**who**." Jesus is the Cornerstone—the foundation of the church. For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." (v 6)

Peter had a unique perspective of Christ being the foundation of the church because of his conversation with Jesus in Matthew 16. Jesus had asked them who they thought He was, and after several of them answered with "some say... this or that," Peter stepped up and said this: **"YOU are the CHRIST (messiah), Son of the** Living God!"

Jesus responded: **"Upon this ROCK, I will build MY Church...and the very gates of hell shall not prevail against it.**" Jesus was not saying that he would build his church upon Peter, but upon the ROCK of truth in what He said—Jesus Christ, the MESSIAH, the Son of the Living God!

Our foundation is not a pastor, a worship style, or even a building. The foundation of the church is Jesus Christ—and HE is unshakeable! THAT is why the church is UNSHAKABLE. It's not because we always do everything right. It's not even because we know what we are doing. **The church is UNSHAKABLE because we have a SAVIOR who is the HOPE of the World!**

And as part of HIS Church, WE are UNSHAKABLE too.



MINISTRY TO BOYS Can Take Many Forms

When the Royal Rangers program first began many years ago it was designed to reach boys with the Gospel message, teach them the truths of scripture, and keep them connected to the church through a variety of activities boys enjoy. Although many features of the program have changed through the years the mission of Royal Rangers remains unchanged and churches all across the country and around the world have employed Royal Rangers as their primary evangelism and discipleship tool for the boys of their church and community.


But due to the diversity of ministry styles and changing capabilities over time, many churches will experience seasons where alternative options are needed that enable them to reach and disciple boys in a way that better aligns with the changing needs and capabilities of their church.

Ministry to boys can take many forms, and the form of ministry your church chooses to employ may change over time as you experience seasons of change. But regardless of the season, every church can provide ministry to boys in some form. Consider the following as examples of what your ministry may look like at different points in time.

- A full Royal Rangers program utilizing all aspects of the advancement system with awards, uniforms, and multiple age groups.
- A "lite" Royal Rangers program that provides boys with the same skills and discipleship pathway as a full program outpost but without the cost and complexities of awards, uniforms, and insignia.
- A custom "club-style" boy's program fully defined by your church using curriculum from Royal Rangers or other sources as discipleship resources.
- Providing gender-based classes or small groups as part of your existing children & youth ministries, such as a teen boys life group or a boys discipleship class.
- Periodic activities for men and boys that bring them together around common interests to build relationships and provide easy entry points for men and boys to invite their unchurched friends.

Every man and every boy needs a community of Christlike men that will encourage and support him in his journey to becoming the man of God he was created to be, and every church can provide that community on some level. If you would like to hear more about the ways your church can be part of that process, we would be glad to assist you.
